



## Top Tips



- When you complete an activity that your teacher has set, make sure that you click the

green

button to submit your work. This means that your teacher can find your work easily and make their comments.

- As you work, click the draft button  every now and again. This will save your work and mean that you won't lose it if your computer crashes or your Internet loses connection.

- Use the draft button to save your work so that you can come back to it later to complete it. This is very useful for your project work, which you might need to work on over a couple of days.

- If you are using a tablet or a phone, you might find it much easier to write or draw on the screen using a stylus. You can buy these quite cheaply from Ebay, Amazon and even B and M. You could also be creative and make your own using the following tutorial!

- If you take a photo of work you have done in an exercise book or on paper then make sure it a close up photo and the writing can be seen. This means that your teacher can mark it and give you feedback.
